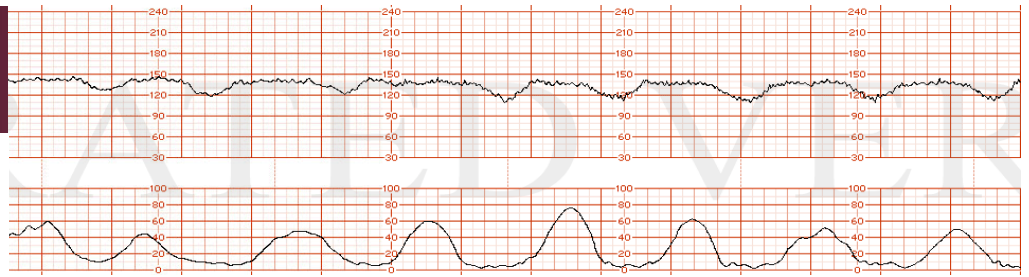

## AWHONN: Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course

This revised intermediate course allows 4.5 hrs. to complete mandatory online prerequisite education, including knowledge checks throughout. The prerequisites must be completed 48 hours before the in-person course, or entry will be denied to the course. 11.5 ce's will be emailed from AWHONN to you following class completion and evaluation.

Order the Intermediate Course Participant Material in print, online or the bundle- order at least 1 week in advance to receive it in time to complete the online prerequisites at least 48hrs before in person class.

If your organization has ordered bulk course materials: You will need to get your own individual access code from your leader, that can only be used by you.

**ABOUT THIS PROGRAM:** Take if: You're a clinician who has completed entry-level/basic fetal monitoring education and use fetal heart monitoring in the intrapartum setting.

This course addresses principles of fetal heart monitoring and may be used as a knowledge assessment tool to validate comprehension of experienced perinatal clinicians. This course includes lecture, hands-on skill stations including performing Leopold maneuvers, placement of an intrauterine pressure catheter and fetal spiral electrode, interpretation of fetal monitoring tracings using a case-based approach, identification of physiologically based clinical interventions, and communication and risk management principles. Online prerequisite education is required prior to attending the one-day course This course can be used to support preparation for certification examinations. AWHONN is approved by the California Board of Registered Nursing, Provider #CEP580.
