- Newborn stations will highlight Newborn Ventilation and Compressions, Intubation and Emergency Medications.

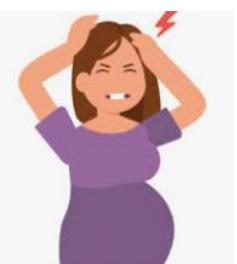
After this education, the learner will:
