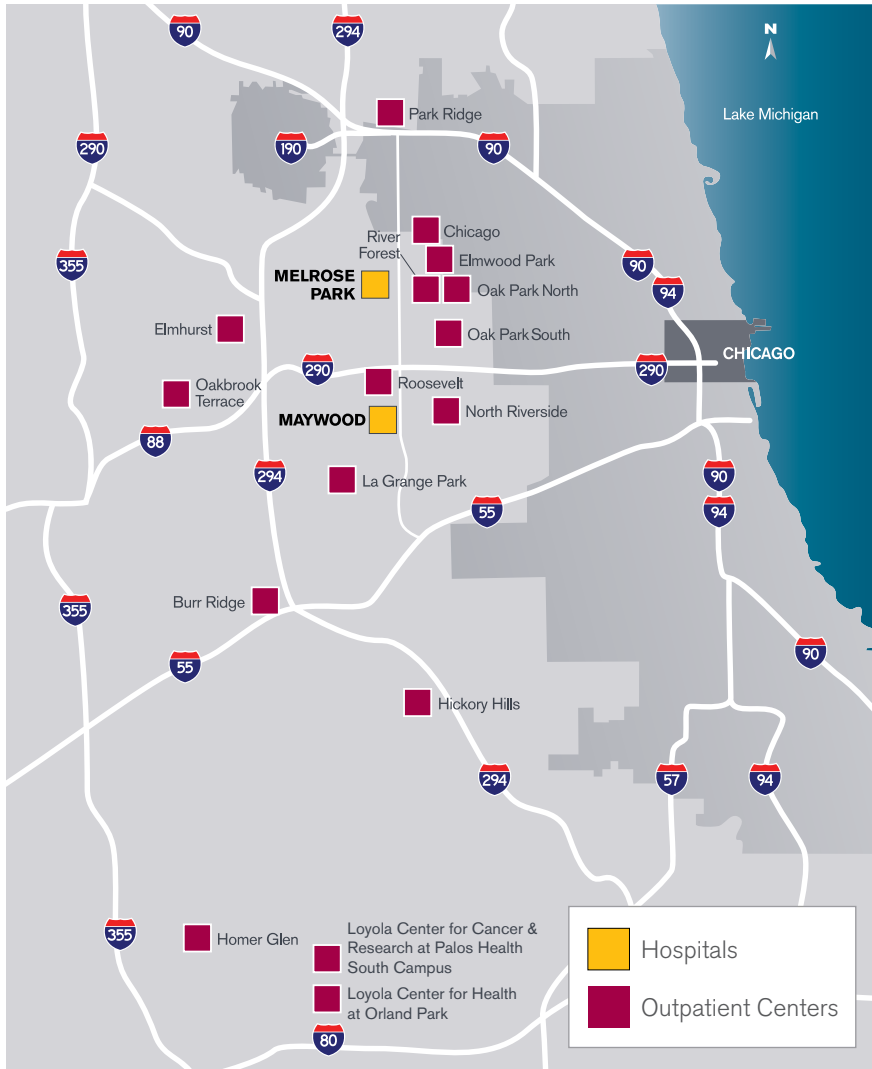


About Loyola Medicine
